

2021 YOUTH CAREER MENTORSHIP SEMINAR

I. BACKGROUND

In recent years, the role of ASEAN youth studying in Korea is becoming increasingly pivotal, not only in socio-cultural aspects, but also in terms of promoting economic partnership between ASEAN and Korea. A significant percentage of ASEAN youth who graduated from Korean universities are today working in Korean companies. ASEAN graduates are employed as country researchers, analysts, translators, and liaison points, thereby helping the Korean companies establish presence in their home countries. In fact, Southeast Asian employees who have studied in Korea have proven to be instrumental in their companies as they have both a good understanding of the culture and practices of two countries.

This year, as one component of ASEAN Week 2021 and in conjunction with Korea-ASEAN/India Business Week, the ASEAN Youth Career Mentorship program will provide comprehensive information on Korean job market and process of pursuing career in Korea. The program will be held both offline and online, to enable more students to attend the program across the country.
